#### **Ambassadors Requirements for Application**

- 1. Age Requirement: Entering Freshman-Senior year in High School
- 2. Has been a 4-H Member for at least two years
- 3. Complete the Ambassador Application
- 4. Be in good standing in both school and 4-H (Club and County program).
- 5. Complete an interview if deemed necessary by Extension staff.

#### **Requirements of Ambassadors**

- 1. Commitment to the Kingman County 4-H Program, including attending at least 6 of your 4-H Club's Meetings.
- 2. Positive Attitude about 4-H and all other 4-H'ers
- 3. Proficient communication skills
- 4. Willingness to promote 4-H to the public
- 5. Promote Kingman County 4-H in a positive manner at all times
- 6. Willingness to participate in Ambassador functions such as leadership activities and five goals set & agreed upon by the group such as, but not limited to:
  - a. Introduce new families to the 4-H program and be available to answer questions.
  - b. National 4-H Week Promotion
  - c. Help Narrate the Achievement Celebration
  - d. Participate in community activities that the ambassador group agrees to participate in.
  - e. Do a community service activity each quarter of the year, including 48 hours of 4-H during October.
  - f. Submit a "Record Book" consisting of: a personal page, 4-H Story and permanent record.
  - g. Host a concession stand for families and participants at 4-H Day
  - h. Organize one service project for the community
  - i. Organize one event throughout the year (ie: Dodgeball Tournament)

#### **Attendance Requirements**

Attend Ambassador Meetings. More than 2 consecutive or 5 total absences may result in dismissal from the Ambassador Program.
