

Kingman County 4-H Record Book Help Sheet 2025

Record keeping and Project Reporting are valuable skills taught to members of the Kansas 4-H program. Members are encouraged to keep a permanent record of all 4-H and Non-4-H Experiences and are encouraged to summarize their experiences on the Kansas 4-H Project Report Form for project recognition.

In Kingman County, we have the following two options for Record Book completion.

Traditional Record Book Option

The following items are the minimum requirements to be included for the Record Book to be considered complete.

The green 4-H Record Book is available at the extension office.

All of the following items must be completed to receive recognition as completing the year in 4-H and receive a year seal at the Achievement Celebration.

- 1. Record Book Check Sheet** (from page 2 of this document)
- 2. Personal Page:** include picture & all spaces signed
- 3. 4-H Story:** There is no specific form required for the 4-H story. Please type or hand write legibly and place it in your record book. Page setup for the story should be as follows: Double spaced if typed, use 12-point font, 1-inch margin on the bottom and right side, 1 ½ inch margin on top and left side, print single-sided, 6 pages maximum. Please include an introduction about yourself, a paragraph telling about the work in **each** of your 4-H projects, and a conclusion. ***This is the story that will be used to determine the “Best Story Award” for Kingman County Achievement Celebration.***
- 4. Pictures:** 6 pictures maximum per page with captions for each photo. Maximum of three pages of pictures
- 5. Permanent Record:** up-to-date
- 6. Activity Sheet:** Filled out & signed, place it loose at the front of your book
- 7. Pin Application:** Filled out and signed, place it loose at the front of your book

Members may use tabs for each of the above numbers in the record book for a professional appearance. This step is optional.

Project Recognition Option

The unique thing about the Project Report Forms is that they help you zero in on the projects you have completed! While expanding and sharing your knowledge! This division is also eligible for county, area, and state awards. To help you with this process refer to the **Guide to Kansas 4-H Project Recognition**. For a project to be submitted for a county, area, or state award, the following are **REQUIRED IN A SEPARATE BOOK**. 4-H members can use a report cover or a 3-prong folder.

Please label each project folder with 4-Her's name, age, project name, County, Club, and 4-H year. For example,

Chris Clover, 10 years old Beef Kingman County Happy Helpers 4-H Club 2021-22

- 1. Kingman County 4-H Project Recognition Check Sheet:** (from page 5 of this document)
- 2. Personal Page:** include picture & all spaces signed
- 3. Permanent Record:** up to date. If the permanent record is submitted with the Traditional Record Book, please check the box on the check sheet. This does not have to be included in the folder.
- 4. Kansas General/Animal Project Report Form:** this form is age-specific to the 4-H'er. To download the correct Project Report form, please select the age division necessary from the list below.

A separate 4-H Story is no longer required for the Project Report Forms. Members will include a story in Section 8: Project Reflection on the form. There is a set amount of space for each age group in this section. Only include information about the project that your report applies to. Follow the formatting guidelines listed on the document.
